

eCribbage League FAQs

Why play in eCribbage League?

League is the team play option at eCribbage.com. Players build camaraderie with one another, enjoy tough competition, and earn badges and Pro membership days for wins.

Who can join the League?

Pro eCrib members

- 3 or 4 members per Trad team
- 3 members per KC, Baseball, and CrossCribbage team

How do I join a team?

Watch the Wall for announcements for team members needed.

-OR-

Talk with one of the LDs or captains about joining a team.

There is no additional cost for joining League.

How do I form a team?

Go to "League Play/Create a 3 or 4 Player Club/Team."

Enter:

- Your team name
- The best agreed time for your team to play
- The type of team you are forming
- The names of your members

Click "Create."

How do I play a League game?

- Join a team and receive a League badge.
- Enter the League Lounge.
- Join or set up a rated game with a fleur-de-lis symbol under Description.

How many games do I play?

In Trad

- During open-play sessions
 - 45 games per session (15 3-game sets)
 - Maximum 3 games per pone
 - Play any pone from any other team in Trad League
- During playoffs
 - Maximum 2 match wins per round
 - Maximum 1 best of 3 match per pone
 - Play any pone from the other team in your bracket

For KC, Baseball, and CrossCribbage:

- During open sessions
 - 15-20 games per session
 - Maximum 4 games per pone
 - Play any pone from any other team in the league
- During playoffs
 - Maximum 2 game wins per round
 - Maximum 3 games per pone
 - Play any pone from the other team in your bracket

Monthly session and playoffs schedule

- Open-play Session 1 runs approximately the 1st — 10th
- Open-play Session 2 runs approximately the 10th — 20th
- Bracket playoffs run approximately the 20th — 30th/31st

How do I track my team's standings and the opponents I've played?

View the official League scoreboard at <https://my.ecribbage.com/captains>.

- Scroll down to find your league.
- Find your team information with your team score, your name, and your individual score.
- Click your name to see the ponies you have played and the scores for those games.
